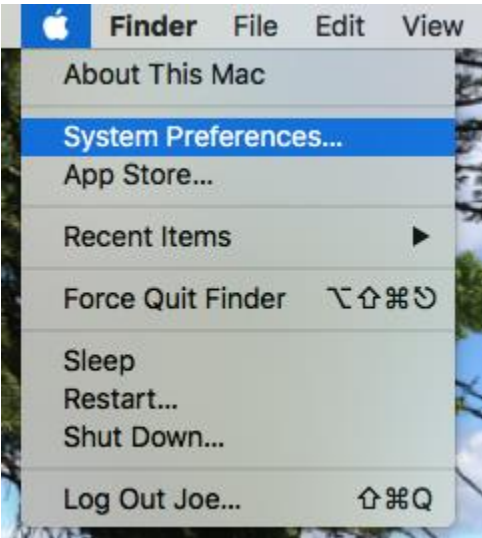


Bitdefender Installation – Mac Computers

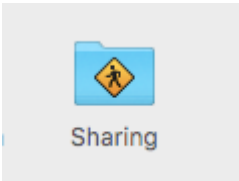
Beginning summer of 2016, Trinity will be transitioning away from our current antivirus software, Sophos, to Bitdefender. Follow these instructions to install Bitdefender Antivirus on your Mac computer. **It is import to note that ALL other antivirus programs must be removed prior to installing Bitdefender on your Mac and to configure the remote login setting. Having multiple antivirus programs installed on your computer would encourage software conflicts and a reduction in machine performance.**

Configuring the Remote Login Setting

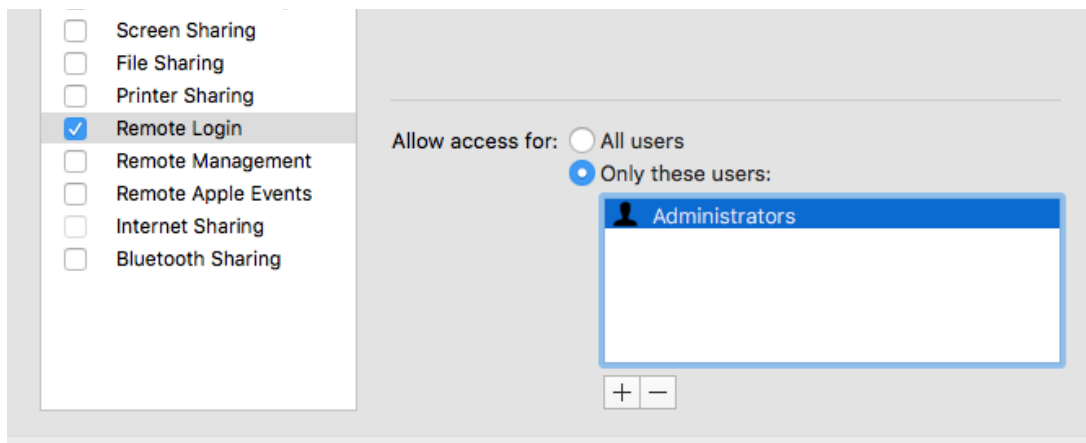
Configuring Remote Login allows your Mac to communicate and receive virus and version upgrades from Bitdefender. To configure **Remote Login** click the Apple icon on the toolbar and select System Preferences.



Locate and choose Sharing.

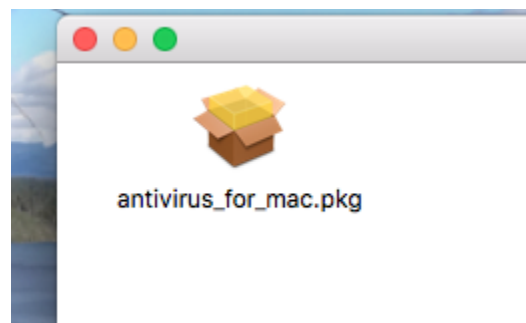


Check off **Remote Login** and exit the window.

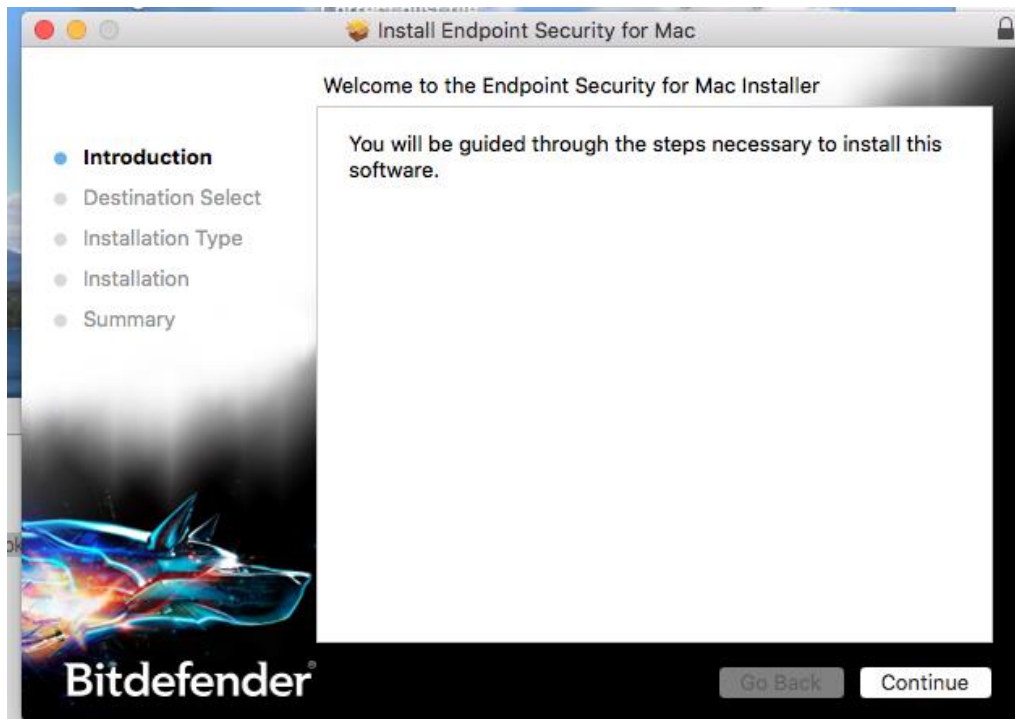


Installing Bitdefender

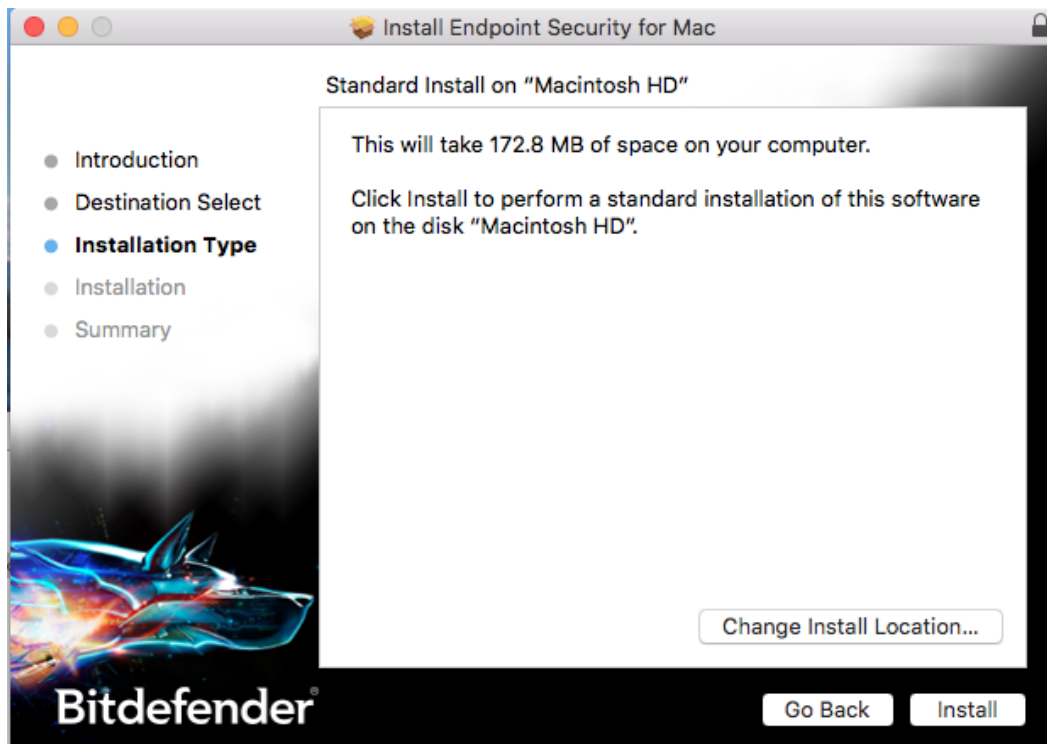
Copy the DMG file to your Mac Desktop. Double-click on the DMG file to mount it, open its contents, and then double-click on the “antivirus_for_mac.pkg” to begin the installation process.



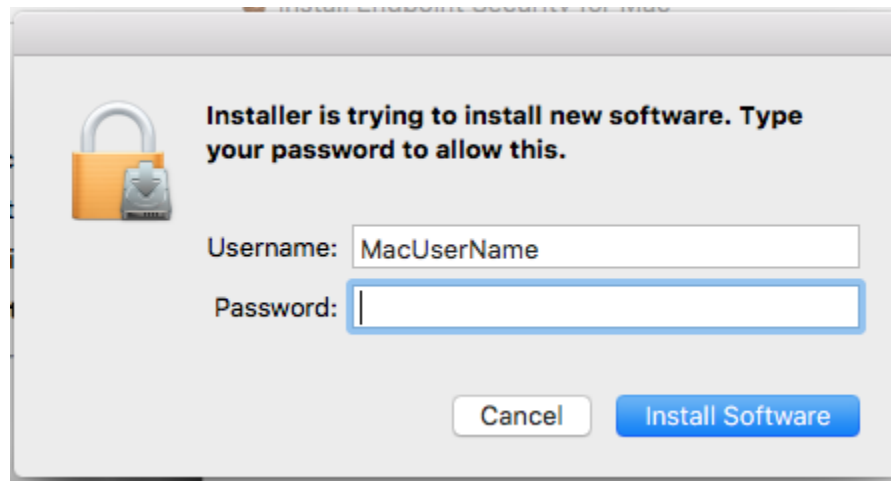
Click **Continue** to advance the installation.



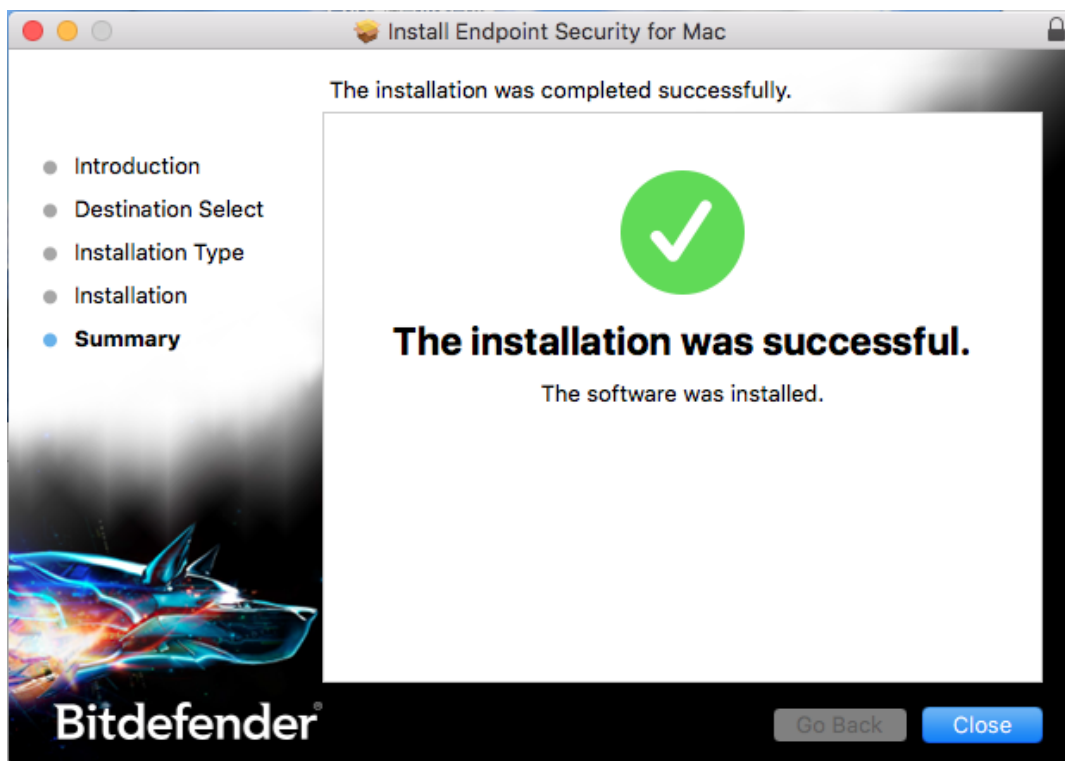
Unless you're an advanced user and prefer to change the installation location just click **Install** to continue the default installation.



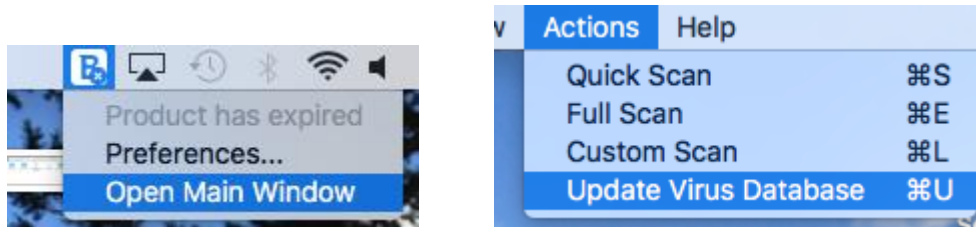
Input **your local Mac** username and password.



Click **Close** to complete the Bitdefender installation wizard and restart your computer to complete the installation process.



From the desktop toolbar find and click on the **Bitdefender icon** and select **Open Main Window**. From the toolbar click on **Actions** and select **Update Virus Database**.



Restart computer when prompted.
